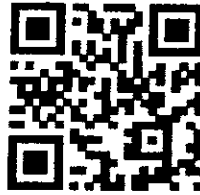
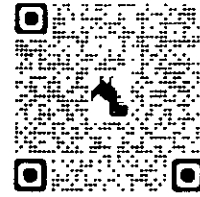

Volunteer Sign Up

Ready and willing to get to work in 2024? Here's 3 ways you can help in battleground areas:

Go – door knock in key areas in other states

Call – make calls from home

Donate – help provide scholarships for those traveling to other states

Team Captain responsibilities:

- Must communicate effectively with campaign staff and team
- Must work out accommodation arrangements, make reservations and cover expenses for the team (2 to a room)
- File for lodging reimbursement upon return to Tennessee (pending scholarship availability)
- Coordinate travel arrangements and communicate meeting with campaign staff at destination

Door-to-Door volunteers:

- *must be capable of walking 4 miles per day* – days start at 8 am and continue into early evening with a brief break mid-day
- must have a phone that is compatible with program provided by campaign and have ability to navigate the app provided
- must be familiar with and able to use campaign contact apps (training for the specific candidate tool will be provided)
- must be willing to use talking points provided by the campaign
- Good tennis shoes are a must. Layered clothing is best as it is usually cool in mornings and warms up. Sweatshirts, jeans, overcoat, socks, and tennis shoes is all that is needed. In a colder climate, add insulated underwear and turtlenecks layers.
- correctly log your visits and results
- limit discussion to 2-3 minutes – lengthy conversations limit the results of door knocking!
- Partner up - one on each side of the street. Stay within eyesight of your partner.
- At the door, ring the bell and back up 10-15 feet. NEVER enter a home or stand close to the door. This is for your safety. You can comfortably talk to the resident from 10 feet away.
- If no answer, leave literature where it will be *seen*. This may not be the front door. Take painter's tape with you and attach to the door or garage door runner. Do not leave literature in the mailbox, but a newspaper holder is acceptable.

'At Home' campaigns

Volunteers can make phone calls from home. Training is typically available via zoom sessions. Many volunteers use their desktop or laptop computers to make the calls and can efficiently make as many as 100 calls in an hour. Share this link => <https://talk.donaldjtrump.com/>
